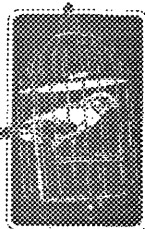

SAFETY FACTS

CO-CHAIRPERSON RESPONSIBILITIES

DID YOU KNOW WORKER AND EMPLOYER CO-CHAIRS MUST:

- Take training respecting their duties and the functions of the committee.
- Receive information on:
 - Accidents causing serious bodily harm
 - Dangerous occurrences
- Are required to:
 - Inspect the workplace
 - Investigate accidents
 - Investigate dangerous occurrences
 - Investigate all the right to refuse conditions
- Keep those they represent informed and post Health & Safety Committee minutes, Committee names and information.
- Have sufficient time for duties and responsibilities including:
 - receive and investigate concerns during working hours
 - Hold special meetings as required
- Accompany a safety and health officer during investigations.
