Paid Education Leave – Manitoba legislation requires employers to allow paid education leave of two (2) days each year for members of Workplace Safety and Health Committees/or their designate.

Child Care – You may be eligible for reimbursement of child care expenses that are not reimbursed through other sources while attending the conference as follows:

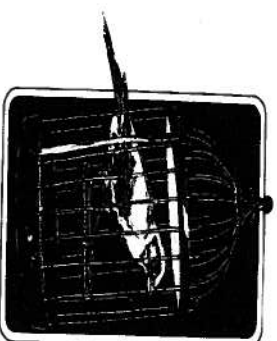
