Workers Compensation Rights

You have a right to appeal your Workers Compensation Claim if you have been denied benefits, or your claim was not accepted.

If you do have a problem, you can appeal. You can and should use your Union representative as an advocate, or call the Worker's Advisor Office (a free service).

There are several types of decisions that are commonly appealed by workers. These include:

- The claim was denied,
- The benefits are not the correct amount,
- The benefits and services have been reduced or terminated,
- The worker is not being provided a service such as rehabilitation or medical aid,
- Rehabilitation services are being terminated,

There are many other reasons so remember,
